- In order for a technical paper to be considered, all authors must submit a 300-word abstract **by October 14, 2005** via the following website: <http://www.4spe.org/conf/antec06/submissions.php>
- Once the abstract file is submitted to the website, it will automatically be converted to an Adobe Acrobat PDF file. Technical papers are then submitted by the authors to the same website in a similar fashion.
- The SPE Division/Special Interest Group Technical Program Chairs and respective review committees will conduct paper reviews via the same website. The reviewers then forward any necessary revision requests to the authors via e-mail.
- The submission website is password protected to ensure the integrity of the submission process.
