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SPE ANNOUNCES CALL FOR PAPERS FOR SPE-ANTEC 2007 IN CINCINNATI
Entire submission and review process conducted online

Brookfield, CT – The Society of Plastics Engineers (SPE) is now accepting abstract submissions for SPE-ANTEC 2007 technical papers. The abstract submission deadline is October 16, 2006, and the paper submission deadline will follow on December 4, 2006. The entire submission and review process is conducted online.

SPE-ANTEC 2007 takes place in Cincinnati, Ohio, at the Duke Energy Center from May 6-10, 2007.

Online Abstract/Paper Submission Process

The submission process is as follows:

- In order for a technical paper to be considered, all authors must submit a 700-character abstract **by October 16, 2006** to an online database via the following website:

- Once the abstract file is submitted to the website, it will automatically be converted to an Adobe Acrobat PDF file. Technical papers are then submitted by the authors to the same website in a similar fashion.
- The SPE Division/Special Interest Group Technical Program Chairs and respective review committees will conduct paper reviews via the same website. The reviewers then forward any necessary revision requests to the authors via e-mail.
- The submission website is password protected to ensure the integrity of the submission process.
