

SCHOLARSHIP APPLICATION (March 27, 2024)

SPE Connecticut Section

This year, as in the past, we will award scholarships to students who reside in the State of Connecticut and are attending accredited colleges or universities, either in or out of Connecticut, on a full or part time basis. Non-resident students are eligible if attending accredited colleges or universities within the State of Connecticut.

To qualify, a student must be pursuing a degree in Engineering or Technology related to Plastics or in a technical discipline having a strong potential for employment in a field supportive of the plastics industry, such as equipment design, material development, technical management, and sales or marketing. The awards generally range to as much as \$1000 and may vary from year to year.

There are two deliverables required to be eligible for a scholarship: **1**: complete the application, shown,

and **2**: Provide an essay discussing how you believe the award will benefit you professionally. The length of the essay should be minimally one half, and less than a full page (14-point type).
