To qualify, a student must pursue a degree in Engineering or Technology related to Plastics or in a technical discipline having a strong potential for employment in a field supportive of the Plastics Industry, such as equipment design, material development, technical management, and sales or marketing

Our technical society, by Charter, exists primarily for the advancement of education for our members in the field of plastics. We also recognize the need to promote plastic education in general to ensure a supply of new members who will lead our industry in the many opportunities and challenges in materials, equipment and process development in the years to come.

Recipients are eligible to reapply. The awards range from \$250.00 to \$1000.00 or more, at the discretion of the Connecticut Section of the Society of Plastics Engineers Scholarship Committee and the approval by the Section's Board of Directors.
