

SPE Foundation 3D Printer Grant Guidelines for

Junior High Schools, Middle Schools, and High Schools

1. The SPE Foundation accepts 3D Printer grant requests from junior high, middle and high schools and, if granted, provides two options for those requests:
 - a. One plug & play unit
 - i. Plug & Play will be the Lulzbot Mini printer – currently valued at \$1250
 - b. One or two kit units
 - i. Kit unit will be 3D4EDU unit – currently valued at \$500 each
2. The Foundation limits our grant awards for 3D Printers to 15 per year for junior high, middle and high schools
3. Only one 3D Printer grant within three years will be awarded per grant recipient
4. SPE will purchase the printers and have them drop shipped to the grant recipient
5. No funds for 3DP supplies will be included in grants
6. The SPE Foundation will provide a list of supporting material suppliers that provide discounts to grant recipients - both to programs receiving a 3D Printer grant and those requesting funds for supplies
7. Follow up letters on all grants will go to the instructor and principle
8. Grant recipients are required to provide follow up pictures and a report on the program progress
9. Project Lead the Way program participation will be a bonus for applicants but is not a requirement
