# **MAY 2003 COUNCIL MEETING SUMMARY**

This summary is intended to help you review the high-lights of the Council Meetings held in Nashville, Tennessee on May 4, 2003.

# **ANTEC**

Attendance at ANTEC was 2,450, comprising of advance registrations of 1,784 and On-site registrations (including participants in the seminar and spouse programs) of 666. A total of 140 registrants attended 17 Society seminars.

Incoming President Donna Davis stated the theme of her administrative year would be *Life Long Learning*. Her presentation showed how the industry is changing rapidly not only in the area of resin manufacturing but also in the area of technology. She stressed how important it is that the Plastics Professionals must also change with these challenging times.

# FROM THE COUNCIL FLOOR

The Council approved the chartering of a student chapter at the University of Alabama at Birmingham.

There was a second reading and a vote to suspend Bylaw B56 with the exception of B56e, h, and y.

The sites for ANTEC 2009 (San Antonio) and 2010 (Orlando) and 2011 (Boston) were approved.

Outgoing President Claudius Feger thanked his Executive Committee for their hard work. Incoming President Donna Davis introduced her Executive Committee. New Executive Committee Vice-Presidents are:Vicki Flaris, Peter Lipp and Rick Wilson. Nancy Hermanson is the 2003–2004 Treasurer and Tim Womer is the 2003–2004 Secretary.

There was a Moment of Silence in memory of Mr. Bryant Goldsworthy, an industry pioneer and innovator who passed away on April 3, 2003.

Karen Winkler distributed a Councilor Career Track form to help Councilors get more involved in the different functions of the Society.

The book "The Will to Govern Well" by Glenn Tecker was discussed in a presentation by Donna Davis.

Executive Director Michael Cappelletti thanked Jim Toner, SPE Director of Promotions and Customer Relations for his 20 years of service and wished him well on his upcoming retirement this July 31, 2003. Mr. Cappelletti also announced his own retirement as Executive Director & CEO effective December 31, 2003.

Next Council Meeting is scheduled for September 20, 2003 in Charlotte, NC.
