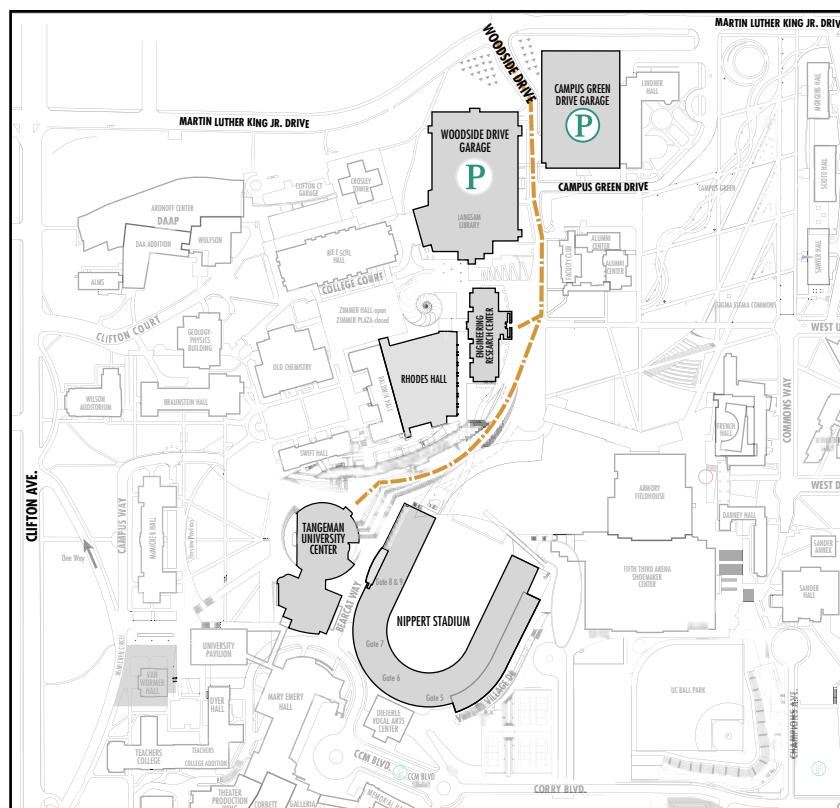

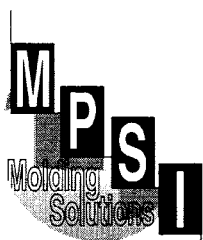

NOVEMBER 24, 2004 EXECUTIVE MEETING

An SPE executive was held on 11/24/04 the following was covered in the meeting:

- 1. February 2004 MVSPE meeting to be held on UC's campus** - We are planning to hold the February MVSPE meeting on UC's campus. This meeting would invite all MVSPE member universities to attend. A brief tour of the facilities/labs and material characterization center would be part of the meeting. Joe is going to ask about a brochure or something from Jimble or Dr. Shankov with list of center's capabilities. Have/invite an industry speaker either Doug Zeik from Proctor and Gamble and/or Gary Chaney from Equistar. Dr. Clarkson is supposed to give contact information to Joe. Have/Ask Dr. Philips the head of CME department to speak. Also ask Dr. Philips about getting a room for the meeting in the Faculty Club. Joe is going to talk to Dr. Philips. Potential places to hold the meeting are, in order of choice: Faculty Club, Alumni Center, Kingsgate Conference Center. The food is tentatively buffet style and MVSPE is supposed to pay for this portion of the meeting. We also talked about the potential of getting industry sponsors or have an admission fee for industry members for this meeting in order to raise some money for our chapter, but nothing was finalized in that regard.

- 3. General Student SPE Meeting** - we are planning on holding the second general student SPE meeting sometime during the second week of winter quarter.
