



ACS RUBBER DIVISION HONORS SIX INCLUDING ONE OUR OUR OWN

During the 169th Technical Meeting of the Rubber Division of the American Chemical Society (May 8-10, 2006; Akron, Ohio), an awards banquet will recognize six individuals for their "exceptional contributions to the rubber industry":

- **Dr. Robert F. Landel,** a polymer physical chemist and rheologist, retired from CalTech Jet Propulsion Laboratory—the Charles Goodyear Gold Medal.
- **Dr. Meng-Jiao Wang**, senior member of the technical staff at Cabot Corp.—Melvin Mooney Distinguished Technology Award (sponsored by Chemtura Corp.)
- *Dr. Vassilios Galiatsatos, project manager with the Novolen JV created by Lyondell Chemical Co. and ABB Lummus Global—Sparks-Thomas Award (sponsored by ExxonMobil Chemical Co.)
- **Dr. Gregory B. McKenna**, Paul Whitfield Horn Professor, Department of Chemical Engineering at Texas Tech University—George S. Whitby Award for Distinguished Teaching and Research (sponsored by Cabot Corp.)
- **Dr. Christopher W. Macosko**, professor in the Department of Chemical Engineering and Materials Science at the University of Minnesota and director of the Industrial Partnership for Research in Interfacial and Materials Engineering—Fernley H. Banbury Award (sponsored by the Farrel Company).
- **Dr. Garth L. Wilkes**, University Distinguished Professor (emeritus), Department of Chemical Engineering, Virginia Polytechnic Institute and State University—Chemical of Thermoplastic Elastomers Award (sponsored by Advanced Elastomer Systems, LP).
- *Dr. Vassilios is the General Operating Chair. of the upcoming ANTEC 2007 in Cincinnati. The MVSPE congratulates him on this honor.
