



TO MILACRON Batavia Facility

From I-275 take the Rt. 32 East/Batavia exit
Follow Rt. 32 East 10 miles to the Halfacre Road exit
Take the Halfacre Road exit and turn right.
Follow Halfacre Road 1/2 mile to plant entrance on right.
Park in lot in front of building.
The SPE meeting starts at this location at 5:45 PM

TO MILACRON Mt. Orab Facility

From the Batavia Plant turn left onto Halfacre Road. Take the Rt. 32 East entrance on the right. Follow Rt. 32 East 7 miles to Bodman Road. Turn right on Bodman Road and travel 1 mile. Turn left on Tri-City Highway. Follow Tri-City Highway about 2 miles to plant Turn left into plant entrance. Follow driveway to parking area.
