The Materials Science Engineering Department at UWM reached out to Milwaukee SPE for sourcing information of Polypropylene sheet and welding rod for a research project they were conducting. The project involved determining weld failure for a manufacturer of water tanks experiencing leakage at the welding joints. With the necessary materials, students could investigate the influence of various weld parameters through data collection, testing, and analysis with the goal of identifying an ideal combination of weld settings to use in their manufacturing of water tanks.
